WELS IN BRIEF

- Third largest Lutheran church body in the United States
 - **1,270** churches
 - **1,394** Pastors
 - 95 Staff ministers
 - **369,221** baptized souls
 - 293,228 communicants
- One of the largest Christian school systems in U.S.
 - 313 elementary schools
 - 403 early childhood ministries
 - 25 area Lutheran high schools
 - **2,377** Teachers





WELS IN BRIEF

- Twelve districts, divided into conferences and circuits
- Synod headquarters located in Waukesha, Wisconsin





CALLED TO PREPARE

WISCONSIN LUTHERAN SEMINARY,

Mequon, Wis.

- Established in 1863
- Has prepared more than 3,500 pastors since 1863; current enrollment of 112
- Provides professors and other instructors to assist in pastoral training in world mission fields and sister Lutheran church bodies, as coordinated by the Pastoral Studies Institute team



CALLED TO PREPARE

MARTIN LUTHER COLLEGE, New Ulm, Minn.

- College level training for pastors, teachers, and staff ministers;
 offers continuing education for called workers
- Also offers a master's program in education
- Trains teachers for Early Childhood Education in its early childhood learning center
- Stable enrollment: 710 students on campus; 107 in graduate program; 3% foreign nationals



CALLED TO PREPARE

LUTHER PREPATORY SCHOOL, Watertown, Wis. and **MICHIGAN LUTHERAN SEMINARY**, Saginaw, Mich.

- Prepare high school students to attend Martin Luther College and serve as called workers
- Enrollment has increased or remained stable over the past few years (LPS at 429; MLS at 218)
- Students given opportunities to gain personal knowledge of ministry on campus, in congregations, through during mission trips





CALLED TO PROCLAIM

WORLD MISSIONS

- Called to proclaim God's Word around the world
- World missions serves 79,780 baptized members, serves 60,000 more souls through correspondence and workshops
- In these countries WELS assists with training 160 men to be pastors and hundreds of people as church leaders
- Produces Lutheran material in more than 40 different languages by
 Multi-Language Publications



CALLED TO PROCLAIM

WORLD MISSIONS

- Exploring outreach possibilities in five additional countries
- Sponsors 38 missionaries, 9 teachers, and more than 60 lay workers in 23 countries
- Makes initial contact with Lutheran churches seeking fellowship or partnership
- Pastoral Studies Institute team coordinates pastoral training around the world



CALLED TO PROCLAIM

HOME MISSIONS

- Called to proclaim God's Word in North America
- Includes campus and cross-cultural ministries
- Ten new mission congregations or mission enhancements planned for this year





CALLED TO SERVE

CONGREGATIONAL SERVICES

- EVANGELISM: My Son, My Savior movie
- ADULT DISCIPLESHIP: Online Bible studies
- WORSHIP: New hymnal, 2017 worship conference
- LUTHERAN SCHOOLS: Supports more than 300 elementary schools, more than 20 high schools, and more than 400 early childhood ministries
- YOUTH AND FAMILY MINISTRY: Kids Connection,
 2016 International Youth Rally



CALLED TO SERVE

CONGREGATIONAL SERVICES

- SPECIAL MINISTRIES:
 - Helps serve people with special needs
 - Prison Ministry: provided 80,000 people with Bible studies;
 70,000 have used Multi-Language Publications translations of these studies
 - Serves U.S military personnel in the U.S. and in Europe





CALLED TO SERVE


CHRISTIAN AID AND RELIEF

- Works with the Board for World Missions to provide funding for humanitarian projects around the world











CALLED TO SUPPORT
